Order No. 1 July 19, 2013	<p><u>M.A No. 598/2013 in Original Application No. 35(T_{HC})/2013</u></p> <p>Heard. Perused.</p> <p>This Tribunal had ordered examination of the location of the site and to give a report on certain points by Expert Team of Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) vide order dated 04.07.2013. It reveals that such examination has not yet been carried out and the Applicant desires a direction to be given to the CPCB to give advance notice of the intended inspection to be undertaken by them.</p> <p>Mr. Raj Kumar, Learned Counsel for the CPCB submits that the purpose for which the examination of the location of the sites is ordered, particularly, giving of the methodology for the restoration and reclamation of the contaminated environment, would not be frustrated, if the advance notice of the inspection as desired is given to the Applicant.</p> <p>Mr. C.S. Dhawan, Learned Counsel for the Applicant /Respondent No. 6 on instructions submits that presently the factory in question is dismantled and the agricultural operations are carried on at the site in question by the Respondent No. 8. He submits that at least two (2) days advance notice to the Applicant, who is staying</p>

at Ludhiana some 200 kms away from the site in question would meet the ends of justice.

Considering the submissions, the misc. application is disposed of with following direction:

CPCB shall give advance notice of two (2) days to the Respondent No. 6 of their intended inspection before the visit of the CPCB team to the site would meet the ends of justice giving particulars of date and time of inspection.

To facilitate speedy service of the advance notice, the Applicant shall furnish to the CPCB his e-mail address, mobile number and residential address.

M.A No. 598/2013 is accordingly disposed of.
