Item No. 2 July 25, 2013	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>M.A. No. 614 of 2013</u></p> <p>We have heard Learned counsel appearing for the Applicant who besides going through the contents of the Application and the documents annexed thereto, has also placed on record the photographs stated to have been taken on 23rd July, 2013 showing that Municipal Solid Waste which was earlier being dumped at the site in question in violation of the Orders of the Tribunal, is now being dumped on the side of the National Highway. The records produced before us not only point out to flagrant violation of the Orders of the Tribunal but reflect the pathetic attitude of the Corporation towards the public interest since such dumping is not only going to prove hazardous to health but even will be dangerous to the vehicular traffic on the National Highway.</p> <p>Furthermore, considering present status of Mayor of the Corporation, he ought not have made such irresponsible statement to the Press as depicted in daily newspaper- Amar Ujala, Bareilly and Hindustan.</p> <p>We are satisfied that it is a fit case where the Tribunal should proceed against Respondent No. 4 and 5.</p> <p>We issue Notice to show cause as to why action under the provision of Section 25 and 26 of the National</p>

Green Tribunal Act, 2010 and all other powers enabling in that behalf read with Order XXXIX Rule 2(a) of the Civil Procedure Code and relevant provision of the Contempt of Court Act be taken. Notice returnable on 05th August, 2013. Both Respondents shall be present in person to answer.

Notices be issued by the Registry today itself.

Liberty to the complainants to serve these Respondents. Dasti is granted.
