	Diversity Board, Bhopal whereby the appellant was directed pay 2% of the gross
	sale or gross revenue to the respondent Board as royalty for access to biological
	resource as equitable sharing of benefit. The Learned Counsel pressing for the
	interim relief would submit that soyabean, what is the subject matter, does not fall
9	within the items enumerated under the Act and that the respondent board has no
V	powers to decide any royalty or benefit sharing amount and thus, the Bio Diversity
64	Act, 2002 is not applicable to the appellant and thus, the impugned order was
	thoroughly illegal and it has got to be set aside and further the Learned Counsel
	would submit that if not, the impugned order under challenge is stayed, there is a
90	likelihood of immediate steps taken by the respondent Board for launching
~	prosecution. Under such circumstances, there arose an immediate necessity for stay
	of the impugned order.
	After hearing the Learned Counsel for the appellant and looking into the
	materials available, the Tribunal is of the considered opinion that a <i>prima facie</i> case
	is made out for grant of interim stay of the impugned order no. MPSBB/ABS-
	Cell/2013/1192 dated 29.06.2013 passed by the MP State Bio Diversity Board,
	Bhopal. Accordingly, interim stay is granted until further orders.
