Orders of the Tribunal

The learned counsel appearing for the Respondents pray for time to file reply. Reply, if any, if not already filed, should be filed within two weeks from today. Rejoinder, if any, may be filed within one week thereafter.

In the meanwhile, we restrain the Municipal Council, Mandi, from dumping any Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) into the river Beas. Not only this, the Executive Officer of the Council shall personally be responsible to ensure that no individual person or authority throws any MSW into the river. The Dy. Commissioner and the Superintendent of Police of Mandi shall issue appropriate directions to all the concerned for strict compliance of this order.

Let the Secretary, Deptt. of Urban Development, Govt. of Himachal Pradesh and the Member Secretary of the Pollution Control Board, Himachal Pradesh and Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) ensure that the order dated 16th November, 2012 which has not been complied with so far, is complied within two weeks from today and in the event of default, they shall be personally liable to be proceeded against in accordance with law.
