Item No. 2 July 30, 2013	<p>Learned counsel appearing for the Project Proponent has submitted that the Project Proponent is not carrying on any stone crushing activity at the site as they are presently in the process of taking environmental clearance from the competent authorities in terms of judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.</p> <p>However, it is contended by the Applicant that these stone crushers are causing serious pollution in the night hours and the statement made on behalf of the project proponent is not correct. Be that as it may, the Learned counsel appearing for the Project Proponent itself submits that the stone crushers are not functioning at the site in question.</p> <p>We direct, Superintendent of Police, Kangra, Deputy Commissioner, Kangra and SDM of Jawali, Dist. Kangra to ensure that these stone crushers do not function and remain closed.</p> <p>In the event the Applicant places any evidence before the Tribunal to show henceforth these stone crushers have been functioning at any hour of the day/night, all these authorities would be liable to personally proceeded against in accordance with law.</p>
