Item Nos. 11 to 13 February 24, 2016	Learned Counsel appearing for the DDA and NCT of Delhi submit that their affidavits are ready and they would file the same during the course of the day. Liberty granted.

Copies of the same be furnished to all the Learned Counsel appearing in these cases. Similar request is also made by the Learned Counsel appearing for the Respondent No. 3. Liberty granted. Copy of the same be furnished to all the Learned Counsel appearing in these cases.

Learned Counsel appearing for the Ministry of Environment & Forest, & CC again prays for grant of more time to submit their submissions. According to him the Team has visited the site and report is under preparation. We feel that the report ought to have been ready and filed today. If the Team of such Senior Professors and Members and the other Ministries can visit the site and submit the report in a day's time, we are unable to appreciate that Ministry of Environment & Forest, & CC could file the report. However, in the interest of justice we direct the matters to be listed day after i.e. 26th February, 2016. We make it clear that the Ministry of Environment & Forest, & CC shall not commit any default. Liberty is granted to the Applicant to respond to all the affidavits that have been filed during the course of the day, within two days from today. Applicants have also filed additional submissions identifying the area to show the activity is on the flood plain. Copies have been furnished to all the Learned Counsel in these cases.

We direct the DDA as well as the Delhi Police to produce the records relating to grant of permission.

Learned Counsel appearing for the DDA submits that original records has been produced. The records

produced be kept in a seal cover, as prayed. The records of Uttar Pradesh, Irrigation Department should also be produced before the Tribunal on the next date of hearing.

At the oral request of the Learned Counsel appearing for the Applicant we direct Uttar Pradesh, Irrigation Department be impleaded as Respondent in the main matter.
