Date and Remarks	Orders of the Tribunal
Item Nos. 11&12 March 4, 2014	<p>We have heard the Learned counsel appearing for the parties.</p> <p>Learned counsel appearing for the DPCC submits that they have received 8 Applications for grant of consent to establish which have been granted within a period of 6 weeks from the date receipt.</p> <p>He further states that the DPCC has issued a Public Notice in three newspapers informing the persons carrying the identical businesses anywhere in Delhi that they are expected to take the consent of the Board failing which appropriate steps under the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 would be taken.</p>

It is conceded before us that despite the Order dated 24th January, 2014, none of the other Members of the Associations have applied for obtaining the consent of the DPCC.

We consider it appropriate for these persons to apply for the consent at the earliest and the DPCC should continue its endeavour to deal with the Applications with serious expeditiousness.

The DPCC shall also inform, wherever identical or similar business is being continued in different parts of Delhi, that if consent is not applied for within three weeks from today, they shall be taking action in accordance with law, and DPCC shall take such action accordingly.
