	We feel that implementation of these orders would

present application. In addition to the issue of MSW, we were confronted with issue of construction of toilets. We, therefore, expect from the Nagar Nigam to place before us their plan for devising the means to effectively implement the orders passed in the said O.A. as well as to grant relief in the present case.
