August 12, 2015	the parties at some length. As noticed in the previous	

order there are 13 CETPs installed in Delhi which are serving 17 industrial clusters. As directed by our earlier order, the DPCC, CPCB and IIT, Delhi would conduct joint inspection of all these 13 CETPs and submit a report on the following:-Quantum and quality of the effluents at inlet-point (a) of the CETPs. Quality and quantum of the effluent released from (b) the CETPs. Whether the CETP is operating to its optimum (c) capacity and as per the prescribed standards. The quality and the ingredients of the trade effluent (d) which is being released by the industries operating in a particular industrial cluster. The Committee shall submit its recommendation for (e) improving, upgrading or any other requisite information for better and efficient performance of these CETPs to ensure release of effluents well within the prescribed standards. (f)These directions shall be complied with by all concerned. The committee shall also submit a report in relation (g)to quantity and quality of effluents being discharged by the industrial unit operating in these industrial clusters. In relation to the 11 industrial clusters which are not connected to any CETP and are directly connected to one STP or the other, complete and comprehensive report shall be submitted by DSIIDC,

DPCC, Department of industries and the CPCB.
