2013	These petitions were filed in the Hon'ble High Court
	of <mark>Punjab an</mark> d Haryana at Chandigarh under Article 226
	and 227 of the Constitution of India inter alia praying for
	quashing of the Orders dated 11th August, 2006. Vide
	this Order the Forest Divisional Officer in exercise of the
	power vested in him under Section 40 (A) of the Wild Life
	(Protection) Act, 1972 as amended by the Act of 2002 had
	directed the Petitioner to deposit the items stated in the
	said Order.
	The challenge is to the Order which had been
	passed under the provisions of Wild Life (Protection) Act.
	This Tribunal has jurisdiction only to entertain such
	cases connected or arising from implementation of the
	statutes stated in Schedule - I of the National Green
	Tribunal Act, 2010 (for short 'NGT Act"), and Wild Life
	(Protection) Act, does not find mention in the Schedule -I
	of the NGT Act.
	Vide letter dated 12th September, 2012, the
	National Green Tribunal has been informed that Ministry
	does not propose to include Wild Life cases in Schedule -
	I. Resultantly, this Tribunal will have no jurisdiction to

entertain and decide these cases.

Consequently, we direct the Registry of National Green Tribunal to re-transfer these cases to High Court of Punjab and Haryana for appropriate Orders and to be proceeded further in accordance with law.

These Applications accordingly stand disposed of from the records of the National Green Tribunal.
