The Lawrence Road CETP plant run by DSIIDC and Okhla plant run by Okhla CETP Society to show cause as to why environmental compensation not be imposed upon them for not maintaining these plants in proper condition and performing as per the prescribed standards. Let these affidavits be filed within two days from today with advance The Affidavits should include copy to other side. documents in support of the evidence submitted.

It is averred by the representative of the Okhla CETP Society that Delhi Jal Board while removing the silt/sludge is pushing it into the conveyer system of their plant and even direct the plant not to be shut during any time, thus creating serious problems in the performance of this plant. We may notice at this stage itself that DSIIDC itself has produced report by NEERI where it is recorded that maintenance of this plant is extremely poor, and suggested short terms and long term measures, which include de-slugging of the equalization tank and upgradation of maintenance standards of the filters appropriately. Similar are the state of affairs with the Okhla Plant.
