Learned Counsel submits that when he was appearing before the Tribunal on 29-11-2017 on behalf of the Association of the Stone Crushers he was instructed by Mr. Tejender Malik of M/s. Astha Stone Crusher, Village Janipur Faizabad, Tehsil Behat, District Saharanpur whose name appeared as at serial no.101 of the noticees list submitted by the State of U.P..

Today Learned Counsel had appeared on whose statement made on behalf of the Association that the matter is listed for arguments today at the final stage. When the matter was taken up today, Learned Counsel appearing for Association submits that the same person has instructed him not to appear. We think that the practice adopted by Mr. Tejender Malik is required to be deprecated as it interferes with the administration of the environmental justice by this Tribunal.

Consequently, we issue bailable warrants against Mr. Tejender Malik for his production before the Tribunal on 5th December, 2017 at 11:00 AM in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- to the satisfaction of the arresting Officer, in exercise of our powers and in terms of the provision of Section 19 (4) (a) of the National Green Tribunal Act, 2010 read with Order XVI Rule 10(3) and Section 151 of Code of Civil Procedure, 1908. The bailable warrant shall be executed by the SHO of the concerned area.

Learned Counsel appearing for the State of U.P. shall forthwith communicate this to the Concerned SHO the name of the concerned person. The SHO shall be present tomorrow before the Tribunal if warrant is not executed.
