<b>Item No. 15 October 15, 2014</b>	<p>The Learned Counsel appearing for the State of Uttar Pradesh submits that they have taken a decision in principle to provide land to the Corporate sector for setting up of the ROs. She further states that the State Government would help the industries to obtain requisite permission from the concerned authorities expeditiously.</p> <p>In view of the statement made above, the Learned Counsel appearing for different industries says that they would take immediate steps to install the ROs to provide potable water to the villagers.</p> <p>Respondent No.26 may apply to the State</p>

Government for allocation of an alternative site which shall be provided without any delay. Till such time the ROs are installed, the said Respondent shall continue to supply water to the villagers by tankers and ensure that there is no shortage of water to the villagers.
