| | Item No. 11 March 23, 2016 | <p>The Applicant has filed some photographs showing that there is not only indiscriminate dumping of municipal solid waste but burning as well.</p> <p>Learned counsel appearing for the Palika Parishad Vrindavan submits that one of the photograph have been to be same place which have and stated to be some mischief and the Palika is taking steps to correct the pits for dumping of municipal solid waste.</p> <p>The photographs certainly shown do not depict the proper state of affairs on the contrary even if the some of the photographs shown to the Tribunal are correct then it will not only be a problem simplicitor of waste burning but would also be of serious repercussions in relation to human health. It is necessary for the Tribunal to have the correct facts before it can proceed to decide the matter on merits .</p> <p>Consequently, we appoint Mr. Rahul Khurana, Adv. present before the Tribunal as Local Commissioner who</p> |

shall visit the site in question as well as take a general round of Vrindavan City and submit a comprehensive report in relation to collection, dumping, transportation and burning etc. of the municipal solid waste in the city with particular reference to the sites in question shown in the photographs submitted to the Tribunal. He shall be a surprise visit. The SHO of the concerned area is directed to provide all assistance and help to the Learned Local Commissioner including Police aid during the visit for compliance of the orders of the Tribunal.

Initially the fee of the Learned Local Commissioner is fixed Rs. 20,000/- in addition to the expenses incurred by him. All the expenses will be borne by the Palika Parishad Vrindavan at the first instance. But we find the facts/ allegations made by the Applicant incorrect then the Applicant shall be liable to bear these costs.

List this matter for further hearing on 07th April, 2016.
