	Item No. 01 to 03 June 10, 2015	<p>Issue Notice to the Chief Secretaries of Uttarakhand, Rajasthan and Himachal Pradesh by mail and the Registrar General shall speak to them personally on phone that they should be represented before the Tribunal tomorrow at 10.30 A.M. without fail. A senior Secretary should be deputed to attend the hearing who shall be able to give clear instructions to the Counsel appearing in this case. The question relate to the minimum flow of river Yamuna from Hathnikund onwards. We may notice that there was an agreement signed between the States of Uttarakhand, Rajasthan, UP, Haryana, Delhi and Himachal Pradesh with regard to the maintenance of minimum flow in river Yamuna.</p> <p>List this matter tomorrow i.e. 11th June, 2015.</p> <p>The analysis of the silt removed from the drains of Delhi, prepared by the DPCC has been produced before the Tribunal. Taken on record. This report is shocking, it shows Heavey Metals beyond the tolerance limits. We direct the Corporation, Delhi Jal Board and DPCC to submit by tomorrow as to what it propose to do with the silt (waste) removed from the drains of Delhi that according to the Learned Counsel appearing for</p>

Corporation is the regular feature, besides specific order of the Tribunal to the effect. We direct the Irrigation Department of NCT, Delhi, Delhi Jal Board, Corporation and DPCC to sit down together today and scrupulously examine the seriousness of the analysis report and suggest ways and means which should be adopted for the purpose, at least for controlling this menace.

The Learned Counsel appearing for the South Delhi Municipal Corporation has brought to our notice that there are three sites for dumping silt, and all of them are saturated. The NCT, Delhi and DDA both will tell us whether it is possible to set up other site for dumping of silt. All the officers shall further inform the Tribunal whether it is possible to use the silt for any other purpose whatsoever.
