Perused Record.</p> <p>The Applicant had moved this Application for direction to the Respondents for formulation of policy for registration of private vehicles in Delhi/ NCR in accordance with the norms: 'one family, one car'. On the grounds that the policy would curb the environmental degradation in terms of Noise pollution and vehicular emissions. We find this plea to be pre-mature as the Applicant has not shown anywhere in his Application that he had approached the concerned Governments with the idea he propounds in the present Application.</p> <p>The Application is dismissed.
