He prays for time to file a comprehensive report in furtherance to our order dated 24th June, 2016. It is also prayed in Misc. Application No. 262 of 2016 that the directions of Tribunal

for incorporating the condition in the tender document that there shall be no concretization of the trees within one meter of their circumference.

The Learned counsel appearing for DDA submits that they have already incorporated such conditions. However, the Learned counsel appearing for the SDMC submits that they would incorporate the same immediately without any default. The Learned counsel appearing for the NDMC and PWD also submit that they will also incorporate the same.

Let all the Head of the Departments of these organizations be informed that in the event of default they shall be personally liable to be proceeded, in accordance with law.

With the above directions M.A. Nos. 262 of 2016 and 887 of 2014 stand disposed of.
