The Learned Registrar will mark presence of each Noticee and if the Noticee is willing to pay the sum of Rs. 50,000/- on account of Environmental Compensation, the same may be accepted. They may be permitted to pay the amount to the Corporation. The amount be collected by each of the Corporation. Offenders who do not wish to pay the amount should be given liberty to file reply to show cause within two weeks from today and those cases will be listed before the Tribunal for hearing and further orders.
