	Mr. Bikas Kargupta, learned counsel appearing for	
	the 10 th respondent seeks time to file report as directed

	It is seen on record that an illegal fishery bandh has	
	been put up in the area concerned at Plot No. 661,	
	Budhkhali to the extent of 10 to 12 HA. The putting up	
	of the fishery bandh in the area is absolutely not	
	permissible which tends to create ecological imbalance	
	apart from environmental degradation.	

In these circumstances and in order to protect the serenity of the Sundarban area we are of the view that the fishery bandh put up illegally should be removed.

Accordingly, we direct the 4th respondent, i.e., Subdivisional Officer, Canning-I, South 24 Parganas, 6th respondent, O/C, Canning PS as well as 9th respondent, Sunderban Development Board to remove all the fishery bandhs from the aforesaid area and file a compliance report on the next date of hearing. We make it very clear that if the bandhs are not removed, coercive action shall be taken against the official respondents.

The other respondents, who have not yet filed their replies, may do so within four weeks from today after serving advance copies on the other side who shall be entitled to file rejoinders thereto within one week thereafter.

Mr. Sibojyoti Chakraborti, Ld. counsel for the State PCB, i.e., 3rd respondent seeks time to file vakalatnama and reply before the next date.
