<p>Items No. 5 December 20, 2013</p>	<p>We have heard the Learned Counsel appearing for the applicant as well Respondents. The applicant's grievance is that his proposal for exchange of 19.503 hectares of forest land to be exchanged with the private land belonging to the property of the Ashram for the purpose of putting up a multi-specialty hospital cum research centre with equal area has not been disposed in accordance with law. It is stated by the Learned Counsel for the MoEF that the Ministry has already taken a decision rejecting the proposal and said decision has been sent to the State Government namely Respondent No.3.</p> <p>The Learned Counsel appearing for the Respondent No.3 would submit that the State Government would communicate the said order to the applicant within a specified time. Accordingly, we dispose the main application with a direction to the State Government namely Respondent No.3 to communicate the order of the Respondent No.2 regarding the proposal sent by the applicant, within 2 weeks from today.</p>

It is made clear that it will be open to the applicant to work out the remedy in the manner known to law against such order.

Accordingly, the application stands closed.
