Order No.8	Date: 16 th November, 2016. Respondents 4, 7 and 8 have filed the reply. An affidavit has been filed by the Special Officer, Padiyanallur Village Panchayat. In the affidavit it is under taken that the existing dumped garbage would be removed within a period of 6 weeks from the date of filing of the affidavit and they will not dump garbage in this site without complying with the MSW Rules, 2016 and obtaining all necessary permission in accordance with the law. Normally the application would have been disposed recording the undertaking. But the learned counsel
	appearing for the applicant submitted that the order of the

District Collector impugned in this application, on the face of it, it will not stand and therefore the order has to be set aside. Learned counsel pointed out that as per the Adangal extract, S.Nos. 34 and 35 are £anksqand not £kalamsqas contended by the contesting respondents and those Survey numbers are situated in a primary residential area and therefore, in any event, no authorisation could be granted for using the said land as dumping yard.
