

within a week and care would be taken to avoid recurrence of scattering of MSW. We can see from the photographs that there are two containers kept at the place seen in the photographs and containers are filled with MSW to the brim and MSW scattered around.

It appears that the Nagar Nigam, Ghaziabad as well as citizens are responsible for the mess around. From the places shown in the photographs, one fact clearly emerges that the containers either are not sufficient to cope up with the amount of MSW or they are not being periodically emptied and the MSW removed to the dumping site. Both these things point out the lapses primarily on part of the Nagar Nigam as well.

We therefore, direct the Respondent No. 2 i.e. Nagar Nigam, Ghaziabad to place sufficient number of containers/dustbin to facilitate the citizens to place their MSW in such containers/dustbins at the said place and such other places and to empty containers on daily basis.

We direct the Respondent No. 2 i.e. Nagar Nigam, Ghaziabad to consider penalizing the citizens found indulging in throwing of MSW on the public street with an amount of Rs. 500/- for every incident of throwing. The Respondent No. 2 shall also keep Gole Park Pond in a clean and hygienic condition in order to check the menace of Mosquito breeding.

In view of the above directions Original Application No. 401 of 2015 Stands disposed of.
