The amount shall be paid to Himachal Pradesh Pollution Control Board. The tipper of the applicant would be released, thereafter. The Learned Counsel appearing for the applicant makes a statement before us that besides paying compensation, they would give an undertaking to the effect, not to use the tipper for illegal and unauthorized mining and for transport purpose.</p> <p>In view of the undertaking to be given and subject to payment of compensation, the applications are allowed.
