Orders of the Tribunal

Rajasthan SPCB

10 We direct that the Secretary Environment, Urban November 19, 2015 Development of both the States i.e. State of Rajasthan and State of Haryana, to hold a meeting and submit the report to the Tribunal in relation to why effluent is being discharged on the land of Haryana, thus causing pollution of groundwater as well as health hazards. They should examine why not the State of Haryana put up a CETP at the mouth of the drains and ensure that release of trade effluent from CETP is as per the prescribed standards and it is recycled for Agriculture and Horticulture and even for industrial purpose. More than 11 industrial clusters are stated to be located in Bhiwadi and around. It should also be examined as to why extraction of groundwater should Dr. Vijai Singhal, Chief be for industrial purpose. Environmental Engineer, Rajasthan State Pollution Control Board has stated that total discharge of industrial effluent of these 11 industrial clusters are 15 to 20 MLD, however, the Officer is not certain about it. The 11 industrial clusters also release 4 MLD of sewage, however, the Officer cannot inform us what is the sewage discharge of Bhiwadi and the surrounding areas. STP of 4 MLD capacity has been installed and another CETP of 6 MLD has been installed. Neither CETP nor STP is discharging treated effluent as per the prescribed parameters.

Let the report be submitted before the Tribunal positively before the next date of hearing.
