In the meanwhile, we direct that there shall be no mining activity carried on by Respondent No. 8 in any manner whatsoever. We further direct the Member Secretary of the Haryana State Pollution Control Board, Director form Department of Mining, State of Haryana and Representative from Ministry of Environment & Forest, & CC to conduct an inspection of the site in question and submit a Status Report to the Tribunal. It shall be clearly provided in that report as to whether the mining is being carried on in violation of the conditions of the Environmental Clearance as well as in a mechanised manner and pipeline has been laid down for extraction of minerals. The Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar and Deputy Commissioner, Yamuna Nagar shall ensure that this order of the Tribunal is implemented forthwith.
