After hearing the Learned Counsel for the parties the issue that requires consideration, pertains to alleged violation in the grant of mining leases and the running of stone crushers pertaining to the issues highlighted in para 3.7 of the petition more particularly based upon the report of the Shri Girish Sharma, Joint Collector, Sehore on the alleged violation on the provision of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and Environmental Regulations. For this the Applicant in para no. 3.7 clause (a) and (c) has levelled certain allegations. The Respondents are directed to file an affidavit of the reply to the specific averments in this behalf on the findings contained in the report of the Joint Collector, Sehore pertaining to the alleged violation of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and the Environmental Regulations indicating the Mining Lease No., name of the lessee, the name of the party whose crusher units were fount not following the directions as contained in the Environmental Regulations and directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court as per the aforesaid report. The Respondents shall also indicate the present status of such parties regarding whom the mention has been</p>

made in the report of the Joint Collector, Sehore.
