Copies be served to all the Learned Counsel appearing in this case within two days from today. She further submits that I.A. No. 22 which was pending before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India has been transferred to this Tribunal and it may also be listed for arguments.

List this matter for final hearing on 04th August, 2015.

The State of Punjab shall submit its compliance report in furtherance to the Judgement of the Tribunal.
