The Corporation has not obtained necessary authorisation for proper collection and Management of Municipal Solid Waste, nor appropriate garbage and waste disposal site has been identified and got approved. It also appears that no proper ETP is established. In other words, presently, Ahmednagar Municipal Corporation is dealing with the Municipal Solid Waste without following the MSW Rules and as such, there is, *prima facie* serious violation of the mandatory provisions of the said Rules.

Considering the record of the MPCB and the Report which is filed alongwith Affidavit of the Respondent No.6 by Learned Counsel Shri Gupte, we direct that a Bailable Warrant in tune of Rs.20,000/-(Rs. Twenty Thousand only) be issued to the Commissioner of Municipal Corporation of Ahemdnagar, in terms of the Provisions of Section 19(4)(a) of the National Green Tribunal Act, 2010 read with Order XV 1 Rule 10(3) and Section 151 of C.P.C. The warrant shall be served through the Superintendent of Police, Ahmednagar. The Bailable Warrant be returnable on 8<sup>th</sup> January 2014. So also, Bailable

Warrant in tune of Rs.20,000/- each against the Applicant Nos.1 and 2 directing them to remain personally present in this Tribunal on 8<sup>th</sup> January 2014, through the office of S.P. Ahmednagar.

We make it clear that the MPCB is at liberty to take appropriate legal action against the Municipal Corporation for non compliance of the MSW Rules, including prosecution of the authorised and responsible Officers of the Corporation. In case, such prosecution is under taken the Learned Judicial Magistrate, may be requested to expeditiously deal with the complaint case filed by the Pollution Control Board so as to decide the case as early as possible.
