	Therefore, we issue directions to Railway Authority,
	that the Railway Authority would place dust bins in
	coordination with the North Delhi Municipal Council
	under whose jurisdiction the area falls. All these Noticees

will pay Rs. 1,000/- as offered by them. This amount, as already directed shall be spent for keeping the area clean and for lifting the waste collected in that area. All Noticees will mark their presence before the Registrar's Court at 02:00 PM today and that list will be provided to the Railway Authority as well the Municipal Corporation within one week from today. These parties would deposit the amount within the said period failing which they would appear before the Tribunal on the next date of hearing.

The Learned Counsel appearing for the Railway submits that the area from New Delhi to Subzi Mandi is being kept absolutely clean. They have further earmarked the area between the Sabzi Mandi to Azadpur as the second phase. Let this project be completed with utmost expeditiousness. The Learned counsel appearing for the NCT of Delhi submits that in furtherance to our order dated 04th August, 2015, he will submit the report within one week from today.
