Learned counsel appearing for Respondent Nos. 1 to 6 accepts Notice and waives service.</p> <p>In view of the course of action that we propose to adopt it is not necessary for us to neither notice the facts in any greater details nor to serve notice on Respondent No. 7.</p> <p>According to the Learned counsel appearing for Applicant the Respondent No. 7 is an industry located in a residential area. According to him in accordance with the Government Policy and the orders of the Tribunal, industries cannot be permitted to run in the residential area and Respondent No. 7 is carrying on wood cutter work which is causing pollution.</p> <p>We direct the Respondents to examine the representation of the Applicant and take action in accordance with law and after giving notice to Respondent No. 7. We make it clear that the Authorities must come to an independent conclusion if the said industrial activity was being carried on in violation of the law and is a polluting industry.</p>
