<b>Date and Remarks</b>	<b>Orders of the Tribunal</b>
<b>Item Nos. 5&amp;6 March 26, 2014</b>	The Deputy Commissioner, Faridabad is present and other Officers are also present. They all regret that the Affidavit by the Deputy Commissioner dated 23 <sup>rd</sup> March, 2014 does not comply with the directions issued by the Tribunal as well as the documents annexed thereto are not proper. He sincerely regrets the same and submits that he has constituted a Committee and within short time after due assessment of the ecological and environmental damage caused on account of illegal mining as well as revenue loss caused to the State in that regard would be

placed before the Tribunal without default.

In view of the assurance given by the Senior Officer like Deputy Commissioner of the District, we would grant another opportunity to the State of Haryana to file a proper Affidavit within three weeks from today.

We make it clear that we will not grant any further time.

Group Captain, Mr. Shukla is present on behalf of the Indian Air Force who is in possession of the entire area. He submits that he would get in touch with the Mining Department as well as MoEF and would put up a proper Affidavit with regard to the illegal sand mining that has happened in the past as well as ecological and revenue loss caused to the Air Force or to the Government of India or to the State Government, as the case may be.

In view of the statement made by the said Senior Officer, we do not propose to take any further action at this stage and would permit him to file a personal Affidavit within three weeks from today. The Affidavit would also deal whether any private vehicles are permitted to enter in defence area or not.
