Item No. 6 February 6, 2014	<p><u>M.A. No. 72 of 2014:-</u></p> <p>This is an Application for initiation of appropriate proceedings against the Respondents for willful violation of the Order of the Tribunal dated 28th October, 2013. It has been stated that an incorrect statement was made on behalf of the State of Uttar Pradesh on 13th January, 2014 that no illegal mining was going on in the State of Uttar Pradesh.</p> <p>Today it is hardly opposed before us that actually illegal mining is going on in that area. However, it is submitted that the vehicles involved in illegal mining and carrying sand are from the State of Haryana and the Village Aslatpur, in State of Haryana where also illegal mining is going on.</p> <p>Let Notice be issued to the non-Applicants. Learned counsel appearing for the non-Applicants accept Notice and pray for time to file the Reply. Let the Reply be filed within two weeks from today.</p> <p>List this matter for hearing and directions on 14th February, 2014 on which date the Deputy Commissioner and the Superintendent of Police of Districts Faridabad and Gautam Budh Nagar shall remain present before the Tribunal and shall furnish complete details of the 23 dumpers which were involved in the illegal mining in these areas. They shall also inform the Tribunal as to the extent of</p>

value of minor mineral involved in this illegal mining. The loss of revenue to the State as well would be stated. The area over which the illegal mining has been carried on shall also be stated by these authorities.
