	They are granted two weeks time to file Reply as to		
	why they may not called upon to pay compensation for		

degradation of environment and ecology resulting from the illegal mining as stated in the Affidavit of the State. We also grant liberty to the State to serve the remaining 35 Noticees/offenders.

We make it clear that the proceedings in this Application shall be confined to ecological and environmental degradation resulting from illegal mining by various person as well as for removal of seized sand against whom FIRs have been registered.

The Affidavit being filed on behalf of the State shall also state the roles attributed to the each one of the Noticees.

All the States are directed to comply with directions contained in our Orders dated 14<sup>th</sup> August, 2013 and 22<sup>nd</sup> August, 2013.

The Registry is directed to put up a note showing which of the States have complied with the Order and which have not.

The Learned Counsel appearing for the State of Gujarat submits that there has been some mistake in issuing of contracts/Orders and no where the mining would be permitted beyond 3 meters depth subject to their getting Environmental Clearance and satisfying other requirements under the law for the time being in force in State of Gujarat.

The State of Uttarakhand is hereby directed to make a statement showing the permissions for mining in the entire State, District wise, the quantities permitted and the period of the permissions along the Form MM.
