As such it is consigned.</p> <p>The Learned Counsel for the Bhopal Municipal Corporation is directed to place before the Tribunal, the rules/bylaws under which it grants business licence to various eating points, marriage halls, restaurants, etc. in the city of Bhopal and the conditions that it imposes under which such licensee is to operate with particular reference to the environmental issues such as generation and disposal of solid and other sewage waste, noise levels to be maintained, the use</p>

of Diesel Generator sets as well as checking of air pollution and the result of traffic congestion, etc. The report shall be filed with specific reference to such installations and institutions being run along the lakes in the city of Bhopal as also other such establishments. The Counsel for the Bhopal Municipal Corporation (BMC) shall also place for perusal of the Tribunal a map indicating major such establishments of which they have record and also what measures the BMC has undertaken for removal of waste generated at such places, both biodegradable and other wise. The BMC shall also inform if any legal action has been initiated against any establishment for violation of condition of licence. Learned Counsel prays for two days time to submit the same before the Tribunal.
