	<b>Item No. 19  January 05, 2018 A</b>	<p>This Application has been moved for stopping illegal dumping of solid waste generated within the limits Respondent No. 2 – Palwal Municipal Council at the site admeasuring 9 acres and comprising of Khavat 114, Khasra no. 14/2, 16/1, 17, 20, 21, and 27 of Village Makpur, Tehsil and District Palwal. It is not in dispute that there is no authorization under Solid Waste Rules for carrying on dumping of the solid waste at the said site.</p> <p>Learned counsel appearing on behalf of Respondent No. 2 – Palwal Municipal Council submits that it is a part of the cluster approach taken for disposal of the solid waste in Almitra H. Patel Case and the waste generated within the limits of the Council is to be disposed of by composting within the cluster of Punhana vide Action Plan at Annexure R (6) to the Affidavit dated 28<sup>th</sup> February, 2017 of the Respondent No. 2 – Palwal Municipal Council.</p> <p>Action Plan fails to give clear cut timelines for achieving the goal stepwise. We, therefore, direct Respondent No. 1- State of Haryana and Respondent No. 2</p>
