Date and Remarks	Orders of the Tribunal
Item No. 1 February 4, 2014	<p>We have heard the Learned Counsel for the parties.</p> <p>The project in question relates to two aspects i.e. the main Thermal Power Project and other the barrage. As far as barrage is concerned the consent Order was passed on 29th January, 2014 and all the disputes in relation thereto were put to quietus as they stood fully settled.</p> <p>Now, we are concerned with the Thermal Power project. The Learned Counsel appearing for the Applicant submits that he has filed an Affidavit dated 30th January, 2014 making certain suggestions and if those suggestions as stated in the Para 3 of the said Affidavit are accepted, then the Applicant would have no grievance and would not have any objections on the ground of Environmental Clearance to the Thermal Power Project.</p> <p>The Learned Counsel appearing for the Project Proponent submits that the conditions stated in the Para 3 of the Affidavit dated 30th January, 2014 are acceptable to the Project Proponent and they shall implement the same. All the other Counsels appearing in this case have no objection in this regard.</p> <p>In view of the above nothing survives in this Application. The parties would abide by their statements.</p> <p>In view of the statement made and recorded, the Learned Counsel appearing for the Applicant does not press</p>

this Application and accordingly, Original Application No. 31 of 2012 is hereby dismissed as having become infructuous. Accordingly, Original Application No. 31 of 2012 stands disposed of and parties are left to bear their own costs.
