UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following O R D E R

Heard Mr. Kamal Kumar Pandey, learned counsel for the petitioner.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that because of frequent road accidents, the victims are not able to get appropriate treatment in the hospitals and, that apart, the financial condition also comes on the way as a hazard. Learned counsel would contend that unless treatment is provided to the victims of the road accidents by some measure, the right under Article 21 of the Constitution is jeopardized.

As we understand, the submission advanced by the learned counsel for the petitioner is that certain arrangements should be made by the Union of India as well as by the State Governments so that some assistance can be rendered immediately, subject to certain guidelines which may also take into consideration the financial condition of the victim.
