	<b>Item No. 14 November 25, 2014</b> <small>SN</small>	<p>Nobody is present on behalf of the Applicant.</p> <p>The Learned Counsel appearing for Respondent No. 4 submits that they have not cut or fell any trees in the area in question where they are planning to construct the temple. According to him it is a private land admeasuring nearly 1309 sq metres and not part of the forest land, which statement is not disputed by the Learned Counsel appearing for the State.</p> <p>The Learned Counsel appearing for the Applicant on behalf of his client gives an undertaking to the Tribunal that they would plant atleast 50 trees of different varieties in consultation with the Forest Department of the State of Himachal Pradesh and would ensure that those trees grow properly and are not permitted to die because of lack of care and protection.</p> <p>Undertaking given is accepted.</p> <p>This Application therefore is finally disposed of with the direction to the State of Himachal Pradesh</p>

to ensure that within one month from today the Respondent No. 4 plants 50 trees of different species with due protective measures. The Report of compliance shall be submitted by the Forest Department to the Registry within two months from today.

The photographs thereof will be filed and the Notice will be issued to the Applicant to participate in this inspection proceedings.

The Forest Department would maintain due records of the trees in and around the site.

The Application is disposed of without any order as to cost.
