<p><b>Item No. 03</b></p> <p><b>July 10, 2015</b></p> <p><b>ss</b></p>	<p>The only relief that the Tribunal can consider in the present Application is that the Government of NCT while raising boundary wall or any other construction, should not damage and or fell any tree. Further if they expose roots of any tree they should ensure that the soil layer is put forthwith and no damage is caused to the tree.</p> <p>The representative of Govt. of NCT from the office of the Deputy Commissioner, Kapashera submits and gives an undertaking to the Tribunal that they would not fell or damage any tree during the construction of the boundary wall that they propose to construct. Further they would ensure that no trees are felled and roots of any tree get exposed, will provide with soil layer immediately and they shall ensure that no damage is caused to the trees.</p> <p>In view of the directions, nothing survives in this application. If any tree is required to be felled, they will take permission from the Competent Authority in accordance with law.</p>
