Verma, Learned Counsel is directed to instruct the Mining Officer to personally inspect the area in question alongwith the concerned Revenue Authorities and Forest Officials and submit an affidavit before the Tribunal personally, whether any unlawful mining activities are being carried out outside the mining lease area of respondent no. 7. The Mining Officer shall also submit in the affidavit whether the material from the mine is being transported through forest area as alleged by the applicant in the petition before the Tribunal. In case that is so, the Mining Officer alongwith Revenue Officer and Forest Officials, shall suggest the alternate route to the owner of the mining lease so that the forest area is not disturbed due to mining. They will also suggest, alongwith their inspection report alternate way and the present route being used by the lease holder of the mining lease in the site plan. The aforesaid affidavit shall be in addition to the reply being filed.
