The Learned Local Commissioners appointed vide our order dated 9th May, 2016 can visit any number of times and submit their reports within one week of their visit.

We direct all the Local Commissioners to visit at different occasions in a team of two or more, as they feel appropriate. They would be within their right to conduct surprise inspection or conduct inspection after informing the authority concerned. In either of the event the State Authority including the Police and D.C. Kullu shall provide all help and assistance to the Learned Local Commissioners to comply with the directions issued by the Tribunal.

- In the meanwhile, we also issue further directions to the State of Himmachal Pardesh that barrier at Gulaba should be re-designed and meanned properly. It should have all the relevant equipments and computerized to ensure proper managements of the tourists pressure during the season.
- 2. The mobile toilets units at Gulaba and other places should be properly managed and there should be effective waste disposal system.
- 3. The sign boards put up should be preferably in a permanent material rather than flex and should be in both languages i.e. English and Hindi.
- 4. All these directions should be carried out within one week from today and compliance report submitted to the Tribunal.

 Rest of the findings recorded in the report should be responded by the State and action should be taken by them before the next date of hearing.
